Expected Behaviors for Children

- Put your shoes on the shoe rack when you enter the dojo
- Put all clothes and personal items in the changing room, neatly.
- Either come to the dojo wearing your uniform, or put it on as soon as you get to the dojo
- Retrieve your attendance card.
- Practice quietly on the mat, or sit quietly off the mat doing homework or reading, until class starts.
- Go to the restroom before class.
- Listen to the instructors at all times.
- Follow instructions to the best of your ability, without being told twice.
- When the instructor is teaching, sit with mouth closed and keep your hands to yourself.
- When the instructor calls break, stop whatever you are doing immediately.
- Ask questions when you are confused.
- Tell an instructor if you feel upset in any way.
- You should not play on the deck, changing rooms, or storage area.
- Do not go into the storage area without permission
- You should not yell or scream, either during class or before or after class.
- You should not ridicule, harass, or be impatient toward other students.
- You should not hit or kick out of context.
- After class, get dressed so that you don't keep your parents waiting. If you do not need to change before you leave, you may work quietly on your martial arts skills
- After class, sit quietly off the mat doing homework or reading.
